- 3 (B) A STATE OR LOCAL UNIT RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF
 4 PLAYGROUNDS OR ATHLETIC FIELDS, TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PRACTICABLE,

- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 18 1, 2018.
